



Michael A. Greenberg Undergraduate Interfraternalism Award Application

Each year, the Fraternity presents an outstanding brother who has made a significant impact in the interfraternal movement with the Michael A. Greenberg Undergraduate Interfraternalism Award. This award recognizes one brother who has demonstrated overall leadership, service, and commitment to fostering collaboration, unity and mutual respect among Greek-letter organizations. The brother chosen is someone who embodies the spirit of interfraternalism through their actions, initiatives, and influence, advancing harmony and cooperation within the broader Greek community and fraternal movement. Eligible brothers must be an active member in good standing with their chapter, as well as holding a position in a student organization outside of their chapter.

Eligible candidates can email a completed application packet to the General Fraternity Headquarters at awards@sigmachi.org by March 31, 2025. All letters of recommendation should be addressed to the Annual Awards Selection Committee. Please submit a single PDF following the format below when completing your application.

Page Number	Item
Cover	Interfraternal Award; professional headshot, name of candidate; university; chapter name; province name.
1	Cover letter from the candidate explaining his background, most distinguishing contributions, and leadership impact to the interfraternal movement.
2, 3	A maximum of two pages can be devoted to outlining the candidate's positions held in his respective chapter, IFC, campus organizations, and international committees. The Candidate should also outline awards received, involvement with the International Fraternity and their community, service to the interfraternal community and/or the NIC, and providing details of relevant initiatives, events, or activities conducted within their position(s).
4	Letter of recommendation from the Chapter Advisor
5	Letter of recommendation from the University Administration or Greek Life Faculty
6, 7	OPTIONAL: Maximum of two other letters of recommendation. Other letters of recommendation. These letters could be from the faculty advisor, Greek advisor, a professor, or IFC leadership.

These packets will be reviewed by the Annual Award Selection Committee, which will determine the winner. Up to three finalists may be contacted to participate in virtual interviews with the selection committee before the winner is selected by May 1, 2025. The winner will be invited to attend 2025 Krach Transformational Leadership Workshop (**from Thursday, July 30th through Saturday, August 2**) where the Michael A. Greenberg Interfraternalism winner will be presented.
