

BUILDING LEADERS

Thanks to your groundbreaking financial support, Sigma Chi, in partnership with the **Sigma Chi Leadership Institute (SCLI)**, delivered more than 5,100 leadership certificates during the 2023 to 2024 fiscal year through its revolutionary **Transformational Leader** program.

The Transformational Leader program teaches critical leadership and career skills that will benefit our members throughout their lives, such as:

- > How to identify and focus on their core values
- > How to persist through adversity
- > How to lead and motivate their peers through change
- > How to recognize character in others


A research study of young Sig alumni conducted by Gallup shows the leadership certificate programs — funded in part thanks to the generous support of our Annual Fund donors — are making an impact:

- 95% of respondents found SCLI certificate programs helpful to their professional success.
- > 96% of certificate program students report what they learned has helped them succeed outside the workplace.
- > 75% of respondents report that what they learned through SCLI programming has been important or very important in helping them grow their careers.

On Track for Additional Growth

In addition to the successful 2024 fiscal year numbers, more than 2,500 brothers have completed leadership certificate courses through the first half of the 2024 to 2025 academic year:

In August, more than 600 brothers completed leadership certificates (Values-Based Leadership, True North Leadership, Servant Leadership, Adaptive Leadership) during the 2024 Krach Transformational Leaders Workshop.

GIVING BACK TO SIGMA CHI

Your gift to Sigma Chi's Annual Fund will immediately support the greatest need of the Fraternity at-large.

Annual Fund dollars support our general academic scholarships, the Transformational Leader program, and ongoing leadership development initiatives by the Sigma Chi Leadership Institute. The fund also aids ongoing historical archiving and preservation efforts, our headquarters and other general Fraternity initiatives.

More than 2,500 brothers annually, on average, support this wide range of efforts through their one-time annual or monthly contributions to this fund — thus providing the most significant impact for our undergraduate members across North America.

Many of these men are members of the White Cross Trust, contributing \$1,000 or more annually to provide more resources to the Fraternity, and to improve the quality and scope of leadership and educational programming and scholarships.

Beginning with the 2024 to 2025 fiscal year, over the next seven years, all donors who generously give \$500 or more will receive a special annual challenge coin depicting one of Sigma Chi's seven founders.

DONOR-SCHOLAR INITIATIVE

THOMAS COWAN BELL CHAPTER CHALLENGE

Through the annual Thomas Cowan Bell Chapter campaign, chapters that receive \$10,000 or more in annual support or endowment-level funding from its alumni and friends receive designated scholarships and enhanced leadership program opportunities. Contributions made during the 2022 to 2023 fiscal year provided these added benefits to 53 undergraduate chapters for the current academic cycle.

LEGACY GIFTS

Alumni and friends can pay it forward for the future with gifts of stocks and bonds, cryptocurrency, retirement assets, a life insurance policy, gift of real estate, personal property (such as artwork, coins, wine) or other general bequests. Brothers who include Sigma Chi in their legacy plans are named to the James Parks Caldwell Society and will receive an exclusive challenge coin.

DESIGNATED FUNDS

The Sigma Chi Foundation holds a variety of funds that support Sigma Chi at the international and chapter level. Through these specific funds, brothers can make a direct impact on the leadership certificate programs through The Transformational Leader program, a legacy event such as Krach Transformational Leaders Workshop or Horizons Huntsman Leadership Summit, or even a chapter's specific educational fund.

Research provided by the North American Interfraternity Conference (NIC)^ has shown that Fraternity members are experiencing stronger mental health and wellness, are better prepared for success beyond college, and have a stronger connection to their campus, community and their peers.

Nearing our 170th anniversary, today's Sigma Chi truly reflects this data. Our members are more diverse, both in appearance and thought, are excelling academically, involved on campus and giving back significantly through volunteer and philanthropic initiatives.

Thanks to your continued generous support, Sigma Chi is exceeding our Greek-letter peers in one additional vital category: pivotal leadership development initiatives and wellness programs. Our Fraternity continues to provide more value to our members than any other Greek-letter organization.

Through **The Transformational Leader** program, our young brothers are exiting their collegiate experience with leadership certificates and stackable credentials that both enhance their academic journey and prepare them for career growth.

According to young alumni surveys conducted by Gallup, 84 percent of young Sig alums report our Fraternity's Transformational Leader programming was important or very important in receiving a promotion, and 70 percent report they were important or very important in receiving increased pay.

Approximately 89 percent of Sigma Chi graduates within the last five years demonstrated strong satisfaction with their undergraduate experience versus 75 percent of all fraternity members per NIC research. Brothers who receive at least two Transformational Leader certificates are two times more likely to be satisfied with their Sigma Chi experience.
