

Order of Constantine Award Instructions



Congratulations!

You have been recognized as an inductee to Sigma Chi International Fraternity's Order of Constantine. Induction to the Order of Constantine is the highest honor that the International Fraternity can bestow upon one of its members in recognition of his lifelong commitment, dedication and service to the organization. Of the more than 375,000 brothers who have been initiated into Sigma Chi, the honor of being named an Order of Constantine Sig has been conferred upon fewer than 1,000 brothers since the Order's inception in 1948 at the 47th Grand Chapter held in Seattle.

Now that you have been named an Order of Constantine Sig, please follow the steps on the following pages in order for the Fraternity to better recognize you.



1 Step 1: Uploading Your Headshot / Photo

Please submit a high-quality headshot of yourself at least 5"x7" with a resolution of 300 DPI at least 1 MB in size. See examples below.

2 Step 2: Prepare for Filming Thank You Remarks

Steps 2-3 are optional for recipients who are not comfortable filming remarks, but it is strongly encouraged for proper recognition.

Please film a brief (2 minutes or less) video answering questions related to your award. Questions can be found in Step 3. This video may be used in fraternity communications, recognitions and related materials, placement in our archives, as well as in conjunction with the Grand Chapter recognition as part of a larger compilation video.

- Briefly discuss the value of service and the importance of giving back to the Fraternity.
- Who is one person who has had a memorable impact on you during your Sigma Chi journey?
