



Sigma Chi Alumni Groups:

The General Fraternity recognizes three types of Alumni Groups in Sigma Chi.

Alumni Club:

The Alumni Club is the only recognized Alumni Group that is not required to be geographically based. Alumni Clubs can be centered on a location but could also be formed around a special interest group or even around the alumni of a specific undergraduate chapter. Alumni Clubs are not required to pay dues, must be comprised of 7 members, meet twice a year, and must complete an annual report and submit a declaration of intent to the Executive Committee with some founding documents and support of a Grand Officer or Executive Committee member.

Alumni Association:

The Alumni Association is the steppingstone to an Alumni Chapter. Alumni Associations must be active and in good standing meeting all the Alumni Chapter requirements for at least 1 year before they can petition to be an Alumni Chapter. They are required to pay the annual \$300 dues, must be comprised of at least 10 members, meet 6 times a year, complete an annual report, and submit a petition to the Executive Committee with some founding documents and Grand Praetor support.

Alumni Chapter:

To be recognized as an Alumni Chapter, a group must meet all the requirements of the Alumni Association and may petition for recognition after one year of active status as an Alumni Association. Upon Executive Committee approval, Alumni Chapter gain the privilege of having a voting delegate at Grand Chapter.

Founding documents required for all Alumni Groups:

- A letter of intent from the group's leadership
- A letter of endorsement from the Grand Praetor (Associations or Chapters) / Grand Officer or Executive Committee member (Clubs)
- Bylaws
- Member roster
- Calendar of group meetings and events
